English Proficiency: Students admitted to King's University College must be proficient in written and spoken English. We will require the following proficiency scores or higher, unless your agreement states differently:

- I.E.L.T.S. (International English Language Testing System) - 6.0 IELTS
- T.O.E.F.L. (Test of English as a Foreign Language) -Students must achieve a written TOEFL score of 550
- T.O.E.F.L. IBT 80 and above (reading score of 15 and above, listening score of 16 and above and a writing score of 15 and above)

# **Exchange Information**

#### **Health insurance:**

All exchange students are required to purchase the University Health Insurance Plan (UHIP) at a fixed cost of approximately \$204 per term.

## Residence:

Exchange students are guaranteed space at King's Residence if they apply by the residence application deadline. In addition, a limited number of rooms are available at the International House located on campus. Residence will be closed over the Christmas break. Additional fees of \$25 per day will apply for those who wish to stay.
